- **Maintain, enhance, and refactor** the existing code base to improve overall software quality, performance, and security.
- Collaborate effectively within a distributed team across multiple time zones.

Responsibilities

- Take ownership of all stages of engineering work, including:
 - o Identifying and addressing technical issues.
 - o Collaborating with the team to evaluate and select the best solutions.
 - Planning and executing the necessary steps for implementation.
- Lead the technical direction of the team by actively sharing knowledge, mentoring junior developers and guiding the team through design decisions.
- Helping to establish and implement best practices in all engineering processes.
- Contribute to code reviews, testing, and documentation of new features and services.
- Continuously improve team workflows and agile practices.
- Communicate with different stakeholders, including government authorities, school officials and different user groups.



Required skills and qualification:

- Experience with Object-Oriented development using PHP 8.2.
- Restful APIs and database engineering (mariaDB).
- Front-end web application development skills: React preferred.
- Experience in app development like React Native.
